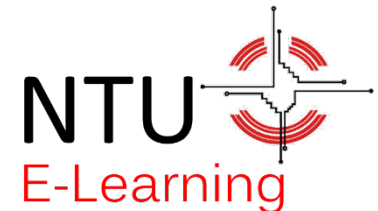

- First, log into your computer.
- Open a browser such as Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Safari to access the internet.
- In the browser address bar, type <http://moodle.navajotech.edu/> to access NTU's Learning Management System (LMS) called Moodle.
